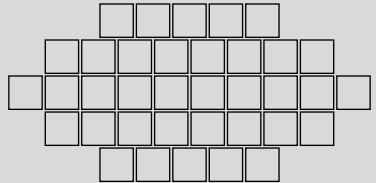

HOW GIFT AID HELPS:

If you are a UK taxpayer, signing a Gift Aid Declaration means we can reclaim 25p for every £1 you donate at no further cost to you. If you pay the higher rate of tax, you can reclaim further tax relief on your tax return of the gross donation or, if you so wish, you can allocate the higher rate tax to your gift. Please consider a Gift Aid donation wherever possible.

By signing the Gift Aid declaration, you confirm that you are a UK Income or Capital Gains taxpayer. You also confirm that you have read this statement and want Lincoln College to reclaim tax on your donation. You understand that you must pay an amount of Income Tax and/or Capital Gains Tax in the tax year at least equal to the amount of tax that all the charities and Community Amateur Sports Clubs you donate to, will reclaim on your gifts for the tax year of your donation.
