In autumn 2014 we shall be opening the new Berrow Foundation Building and the refurbished Garden Building, both behind the Rector's Lodgings. These two building projects will provide us with a new and much needed larger MCR, music practice rooms and a refurbished Oakeshott room.

The College has instructed Luke Hughes (www.lukehughes.co.uk), the distinguished furniture designer, to hand craft 120 chairs to furnish the upper floors of the building, including the Oakeshott Room. The chairs will be constructed from solid European oak, upholstered in leather, and are designed to last for many decades.

We would like to offer alumni and friends of the College the opportunity to 'name a chair' for themselves or others and become a lasting part of this project. Naming a chair presents a unique opportunity to commemorate your time at Lincoln, or to honour the memory of a loved one. For a donation of \$1,000, or instalments of \$27.78 per month for 36 months, the name of your choice will be inscribed on a brass disc displayed on the back panel for the lifetime of the chair.


